On June 15, 2023, from 5:30 – 7:00 p.m., the City of Monroe’s Planning & Urban Development Department –Community Development Office will host a public hearing at the Public Safety Center, 1810 Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, Monroe, LA 71202 to discuss planned projects and activities to be funded with FY 2023 entitlement dollars for the allocation of Community Development Block Grant Funds (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships funds (HOME).
